


Architectural Review Committee (ARC)

General

- \Box Arrange for home visits
- □ Set seasonal hold cable/internet
- □ Set security system
- □ Store outdoor furniture
- □ Store propane tank (townhomes)
- □ Turn off accent lightning
- □ Secure checkbooks, passports, password books and documents

Security

- □ Lock windows/doors, close shades
- □ Block slider tracks
- □ Change smoke detector batteries
- □ Change electronic lock batteries and garage keypad batteries
- □ Secure keys, openers, fobs

Interior

- □ Fans off
- □ Overhead lights off

Homeowner Extended Leave Checklist

Interior - Continued

- □ Unplug lamps, appliances, TV
- □ Ice maker off
- \Box Check food for expiration dates
- \Box Store open food in containers
- □ Empty trash
- □ Arrange final pickup for trash/recycling
- □ Spray for insects/set traps

HVAC

- □ AC tune-up
- □ Change furnace filters
- □ Set temperatures 55 heat/85 cool
- □ Turn off fireplace gas
- □ Clean area around condenser
- □ Make sure "smart home" features work

Water

- □ Water heater vacation setting
- □ Water softener fill/turn off
- □ Turn off water, wall valves *townhomes*, main shutoff outside *villas*

Vehicles

- □ Fuel/wash
- □ Change oil
- □ Set trickle charger
- □ Increase tire pressure
- □ Set tires on pads
- \Box Block exhaust ports
- □ Dryer sheets for interior
- \Box Separate windshield wipers from glass
- Store e-bike batteries at proper charge and temperature
